TERMS & REGULATIONS

- Open to students in grades 9-12 that reside in Charleston, Berkeley, or Dorchester County.
- Limited to one entry per student. No entry fee required.
- Entry must be original, three-dimensional artwork. Sculpture must be free-standing and stable.
- Entries will be accepted on behalf of students from one authorized representative of their school or home school network.
- Each school is limited to an all-inclusive maximum of 10 entries, combining all grade levels on one log sheet.
- In order to meet the limited number of entries, schools may wish to have a contest or school judging in order to select student pieces for the exhibition.
- Art must be ready for exhibition upon delivery. Sculptures will be displayed on tables.
- Maximum size, for all grades, is 18H" x 12W" x 12"D.
- Entries must be clearly labeled with artists' names and school. Completed Entry ID Sheets must also accompany each entry. See provided Entry ID Sheet.
- Sponsor reserves the right to reject any entry that does not meet the eligibility requirements or is inappropriate for public exhibition. Contact the Cultural Arts Dept. with any questions.
- Exhibition facilities have a professional security system and the exhibition is monitored.
- Sales inquiries will be forwarded to authorized school representative. No commission will be charged.
- Sponsor reserves the right to use images of work and/or exhibition for publicity.
- By submission of entries, the artist accepts all conditions and terms set forth in this prospectus.

JUDGING GUIDELINES

Awards will be at the sole discretion of the judge.

We are pleased to announce the judge for this inaugural competition & exhibition is Jarod Charzewski, local sculptor and Associate Professor in the Department of Studio Art at the College of Charleston. Charzewski holds a BFA from the University of Manitoba and an MFA from the University of Minnesota. He has received artist grants from several US and Canadian arts organizations, including the Manitoba Arts Council and the Canada Council for the Arts, and received a Puffin Award for the environmental content of his work. He has exhibited across the US and Canada, including such venues as the Grand Canyon National Park site specific installation, Le Biennale de Montreal in Montreal, Quebec, and the Bunnell Arts Center in Homer, AK. In addition, he recently had a mid-career retrospective at the Begovich Gallery at the University of Southern California, Fullerton.

AWARDS

Award ribbons will be placed by 6:00pm on Wed., May 1. Winners will be formally acknowledged at the Exhibition Encore in Exhibit Hall A at Noon on Sun., May 5. Each winner will receive an award ribbon, a festival merchandise item, and a gift card equal to the prize amount. School representatives will pick up artwork, awards, participation ribbons, and prizes and distribute them to the students back at school.
